Rom. 12:3

'...do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you.'

The idea is that God has allotted to each believer a standard of faith by which to measure himself and that standard is Christ. If Christ is our standard, the tendency to exalt ourselves by comparing ourselves with others will be curbed (R. Kent Hughes).
